

## AIR STATION VANDEL

Air Station Vandel is located in the middle of the peninsula named Jutland, where uplands and high moors alternate with great flat stretches of cultivated sanded land. The climate is typical coastal-climate, windy and with passing low pressures from the North Atlantic Sea giving a lot of rain and rainshowers. The temperature is moderate both summer and winter, being around 16° C in the summer and 0° C in the winter.

The nearest cities are Vejle (40.000 pop.) and Kolding (35.000 pop.). The smaller towns next to the Air Station are Vandel, Billund and Grindsted.

Air Station Vandel is a deployment base for national and NATO Forces. The Air Station is also base for RDA Air Corps.

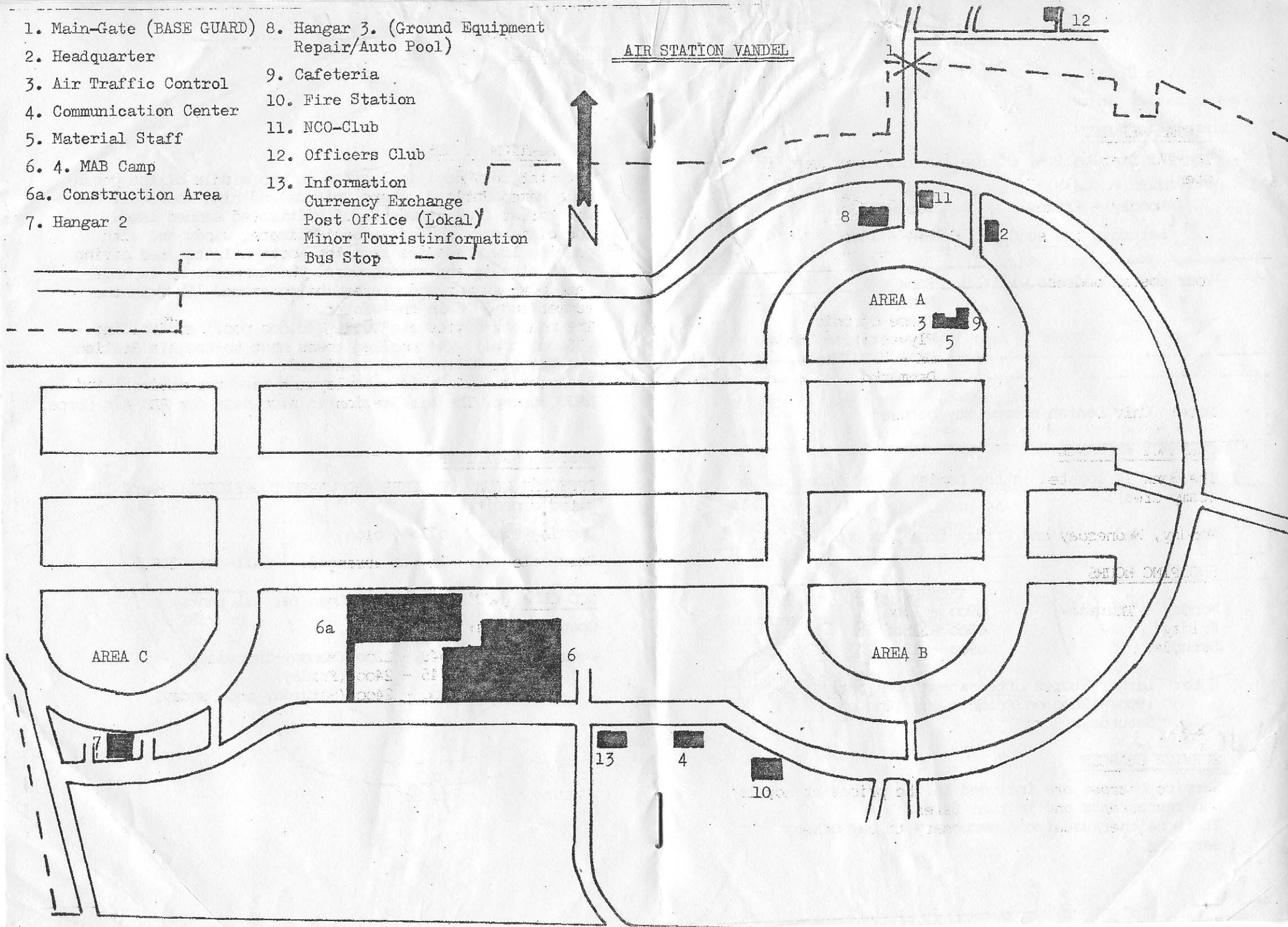

### TRANSPORT (Internal)

Speed limit on the Air Station is 70 km/h.

Private vehicles are on no account allowed on taxiways and runways. Military vehicles may be operated on taxiways in squadron areas. Before entering runway areas, permission from ATC is necessary (by radio call). Service cars and private cars may be operated all over the Air Station on roads open for traffic. Please note that parking is not allowed outside marked parking areas.

There is a shuttle bus running for transportation between 4. MAB Camp and the Main Gate.

### COMMERCIAL TRANSPORT (BUS-TRAIN-AIR)

Busses (No 912) runs between Vandel and Vejle/Grindsted/ Billund. The bus-stop is located close to the Grill Bar in Vandel Town (200 meters from the Main Gate).

From Vejle Railway Station you can reach any place in Denmark within 5 hours by train.

Scandinavian Airlines System (SAS/DANAIR) has several daily flights from Billund to Copenhagen. For reservation/information ask the Danish Information (in the camp area) ext. 349.

Bus-schedule available free of charge at the Danish Information (in the camp area).

### SERVICE CHARGES

Service charges are included in the prices at hotels and restaurants and in taxi fares.  
It is neither usual nor necessary to pay other services.

You may order ext. number in English, but further communication in English with the switchboard operators cannot be expected.

Private telephone calls to persons outside the Air Station must be made from the Public Telephone Box and not through the Air Station switchboard. Public Telephone Box' is located in building 30 (Cafeteria).

Duty calls from the Air Station may be made through the Air Station switchboard.

## SECURITY

Normal military security regulations are to be observed during your stay at Vandel Air Station. However, a few points should be emphasized:

- Your current ID-card should be shown, upon request to any guard or patrol on the Air Station
- Photography is not allowed - whether on the Air Station or towards it from positions outside the Air Station.
- When leaving or arriving at the Air Station - always use the Main Gate.
- Never enter unauthorized areas at the Air Station. Dog patrols (loose dogs) are constantly patrolling these areas.
