FLEET MARINE FORCE c/o FLEET FOST OFFICE, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA BURLARY OF THE COTTES ACTIVITIES lay lat brought a fitting climax to the operations of a fine squadron when, on this last day of operations prior to decommissioning, twelve (18) Coresirs from Marine Fighting Squedron 251 flew in close support for ground forces at Sulpa. Leyto Taland. An assigned terret ares in the pash of the Becond Philippine Bettellion was blankoted with bombs and covered by straffing. The Commander of the ground forces reported excellent covered. By Wing General Order No. 14-1945 (1st MAW, PMF), deted 24 May 1945, the squadron was decommissioned effective 1 June 1945. All but thirteen (13) of its officer personnel wore absorbed into the other laring direrest Group Fourteen aquadrone as replacement or augmentation, the effective date of trenefer heving been 30 April 1945. Of the remaining thirteen (13) officers, twelve (12), who had completed their tour of duty oversees, were deteched to Personnel Group, Franc, MCAD, Transp. on Mego, California, and the thirteenth went to arine Fighting Squadron 222. Fellones W. Filliow served es Commanding Officer of the squedron until the dete of his detechment to the United States on 21 May 1945. He was succeeded by First Lieutenent Clen F. KEITHIEY. arine Corps and Havy Tha and T/A meterial was turned in to the Group Quartermenter. Recreation property on hand was turned in to the Group's Recreation Officer for reallocation to the remaining equadrons within the Group. And so, with the performence on May let of their lest mismion, which received the frequent and well deserved label of excellent, and upon the execution of the administrative metters srising from its dissolution, marine Pighting Squadron 251 wrote its finis and went out of existence.
